


Annual WALK FOR LIFE; a visible voice for all.

'I just want my baby back':



A Reddit poster recently shared the story of her abortion pill experience, including two photos of her 10-weekold deceased baby, which she named "Bean." Her comments illuminate the trauma and anguish that many women experience after taking the abortion pill.

"20 minutes ago I had an MA [medication abortion] at home and it was the most painful thing I've ever gone through. I'm so sorry little bean," the poster wrote. "Bean was moving its legs and heart was still beating when it came out in one push." She also stated that she was not prepared to see her baby. "I was not informed the fetus would be whole. So it was quite a shocking moment when I saw it. I don't think I was prepared well enough at all for the entire experience," "I consulted with a doctor and unfortunately they did not mention once that I would see that and what to do with it after,"

Later, she <u>stated</u>: "It was not an easy choice. It was one that I thought about for a long time trying to decide. Now I'm not sure I made the right decision," "it's definitely the hardest thing I've ever done in my life and one that I regret, I'll never forget that experience ever."

Days after the experience, the poster wrote: "Life still feels like a sick fever dream that I can't

escape," finally concluding, "I just want my baby back. This is so hard." www.liveaction.org/

'From "My Body, My Choice" to Hope in Jesus.' by Sarah Eekhoff Zylstra

Since *Roe v. Wade* was overturned in 2022, public opinion about abortion has <u>changed dramatically</u>. There's been a <u>softening</u> among those who previously favored a total ban and greater intensity among pro-abortion voters. Today, <u>more</u> of the religiously unaffiliated say they won't vote for any pro-life candidate. And this summer, for the first time in 40 years, the GOP <u>released a platform</u> that didn't call for national limits on abortion. Despite the victory at the highest court, Americans increasingly reject the pro-life message. For pro-life believers, this reality can feel overwhelming. It's hard to know how to respond personally, politically, or as a church community.

That's why I found Sarah Eekhoff Zylstra's recent <u>story</u> (www.thegospelcoalition.org/article/my-body-choice-jesus/) about Heidi Jenkins so encouraging. If you ask Jenkins what brought her to the Lord, she'll tell you it was the guilt she felt after her second abortion. Jenkins immediately regretted it. "I was completely traumatized," she told Zylstra, "Sad and angry at all the people who had advised me [to abort]. I was ashamed, guilt-ridden, anxious, depressed."

Around that time, Jenkins's sister invited her to hear Chuck Colson tell how he'd accepted Christ while in prison. "Although he'd made choices he regretted, he radiated a peacefulness and a joy I was envious of," said Jenkins. At Colson's invitation, Jenkins prayed to receive Christ. Then she was discipled through Bible Study Fellowship and Redeemer Presbyterian Church. Today, Jenkins is a trained biblical counselor who has provided care for hundreds of pre- and post-abortive women.

Isn't that incredible! What sparked the change in Jenkins's life? Simply hearing a fellow sinner tell how he'd found forgiveness in Jesus. No matter how far our culture falls, we put our faith in the <u>powerful message of Christ's pardon</u>. Our God continues to pursue sinners to the depths. Though we live in a world where death reigns, we can keep sharing our faith. Let's do the plodding work of everyday discipleship because our confidence is in him.
