

A bit of history: The annual "Walk for Life" on the first weekend of October is the way that Smithers Pro-life combines 2 national events into one. Like many communities across Canada, in early October the LIFE CHAIN is when participants stand for an hour along a main road holding educational signs. The second event is a VIGIL or WALK FOR LIFE in May that Smithers Pro-life did on the hospital grounds. The Life Chain dwindled because of cold weather and the highway was unsafe for children; the Vigil lost its venue because it was banned from using the hospital grounds.

Smithers Pro-Life decided to turn the Chain into a walk; both to stay warm and have less time along a busy highway and to incorporate the Vigil as a stop for prayer in front of the hospital.

The Walk begins in the St. Joe's Parish parking lot, follows a route through town and then returns to St Joe's one and a half hours later. Your participation in this walk is an excellent way to let others know that human life has value and that neither women nor babies are helped by abortion.

Breakpoint

If you are looking for support and information to carry on with being the Christian influence in our Culture, *one very useful resource is Breakpoint*; it empowers Christians everywhere with a Christian worldview.

Chuck Colson often talked about the ripple effect of truth-filled conversations—how they could shape families, friendships, and communities. In his book *How Now Shall We Live?*, he put it like this:

If our culture is to be transformed, it will happen from the bottom up - from ordinary believers practicing apologetics over the backyard fence or around the barbecue grill.

Decades later, this sentence is still true. God uses the everyday conversations we have with our friends, neighbors, and co-workers. But too many Christians don't speak up. To have the confidence we need, we first need clarity. And that's not always easy.

We're surrounded by noise. False narratives. Dangerous ideas. Harmful ideologies creep into how we think, often without us realizing it. That's why clarity—biblical clarity—isn't just helpful. It's essential.

That's how Chuck envisioned *Breakpoint*, and that's what it still exists to do: not just inform but cut through the noise with clarity and anchor us in truth.
